This funding will be used to

- **Attendance** - at least 95% for each student
- **Reading** – 85% or better achieving the district benchmark (in Prep to Year 2) or at or above chronological age
- **Level of Achievement** –
 - **English** - 20% of students in each cohort from Prep to Year 6 will achieve an ‘A’ standard in English
 - **Mathematics** – 25% of students in each cohort from Prep to Year 6 will achieve an ‘A’ standard in Mathematics

Our initiatives include

Pedagogy:

- Provide professional development and coaching to deepen teacher’s understanding of the Australian Curriculum with particular focus on the vertical integration of English and Mathematics

Literacy and Numeracy:

- Embed schoolwide consistent approaches to the teaching of Reading, Writing and Numeracy
- Provide additional support to class literacy programs through the employment and training of Literacy Assistants, embedding of whole school framework for the development reading and writing skills
- Continue to utilise PD opportunities, peer coaching and mentoring opportunities to identify and implement high yield strategies in Reading, Writing and Numeracy.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Using a schoolwide approach to the teaching of Reading, Writing and Numeracy.
- Continuing to develop the professional pedagogy of teachers and teachers’ aides through – peer support, teacher and teacher aides release, coaching and collaborative inquiry cycles
- Monitoring the progress of all students and use feedback, feed forward and feed up to ensure students and teachers clearly understand the success criteria in English and Mathematics.
